THE APPEAL 2024

The Appeal 2024 has officially launched. You should have received a letter from the Bishop, as well as from Father O'Connor. If you have NOT received a letter from Fr. O'Connor, *please* see Heather in the Parish Office. We work hard to have accurate contact info for our parish. Please stop by the office to provide your mailing address, so that you are included as a parishioner here. Not only for future mailings, but for census purposes, as well.

There are Appeal 2024 envelopes in the Narthex if you would like to make your pledge and payment. Last year, both parishes were successful in reaching the set goal for each location. For 2023, SJXXIII Parish surpassed their goal by more than ten thousand dollars and St. Mary met their goal for the first time in many years. Thank you to all who contributed to this last year, let's do it again this year!

St. Mary's parish goal is \$27,005.40. St. John XXIII parish goal is \$47,742.95 for The Appeal 2024. In the coming months, St. Mary, Groveport, and St. John XXIII will become one vibrant, unified parish. With this merger, we face a unique situation regarding our financial goals for The Appeal. Canonically, the merging of financial interests among parishes is not permitted before the official merger. While combining parish goal amounts may seem easier at the beginning of the campaign, it is not recommended. Once the merger of our parishes is completed, we will come together and have one combined Appeal goal of \$74,748.35. We believe we can surpass the combined total of \$74,748.35. As in years past, anything over the goal we collect will be returned to the parish to use for parish needs. Let's make The Appeal 2024 another year of success!

HOSPITALITY SUNDAY - WE NEED VOLUNTEERS

If you have an interest in gardening and would like to use your talents to help establish a community garden here at the campus of SJXXIII, we would like to talk with you! There will be an informational meeting in the next couple of months. In the meantime, watch the bulletin and sign up on Flocknote under the group "Gardening" to receive future information.

TRANSITION TEAM UPDATE

This criterion was at the forefront when planning for the next step in our merging process, one campus.

During the townhall meetings, one of the questions posed to the participants at each table was "What is important to you regarding the future needs of the single campus the parish will occupy?" The most common responses were:

- Space to grow think multigenerational
- Accessibility to building and restrooms, accommodations for people with different abilities or needs
- Functional kitchen space
- More accommodations for aging parishioners
- Rectory onsite of campus
- Outdoor stations of the Cross

Next steps after suppression is to become one campus. The Transition Team (TT) along with the senior director of real estate for the Diocese of Columbus, Andy Johanni, have reviewed the options to help determine the best location for the future campus of The Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This involved reviewing the property evaluations, financial costs to operate each location, deferred maintenance costs, etc. The property reports show many items, including the deferred maintenance and the cost to bring each property up to regular maintenance, using a 10-year deferred maintenance plan. This plan was part of an evaluation provided by a property inspection. The research for one campus includes the above items as well as the cost of the possibility of purchasing a new property, best use of each property, size of current buildings, parking, cost of operation, etc.

In August, 2023 both locations were inspected and provided a report of opinion of probable cost for future budgeting purposes as well as health of each campus. Please note, this is the deferred and anticipated cost for maintenance of each location annually.

Deferred and anticipated maintenance costs summary for both locations:

St. Mary, Groveport rectory – estimated deferred maintenance \$87,200.00. To recapture the rectory to "good health" will cost approximately \$8,720.00 annually over 10 years toward deferred maintenance items which include new roof, new gutters and downspouts, upgrade to lighting, etc. St. Mary, Groveport church building – estimated deferred maintenance \$564,500.00. To recapture the church building to "good health" will cost approximately \$56,450 annually over 10 years toward deferred maintenance items which include needing a new roof, ADA compliant entrance, replacement of the entire electrical system and HVAC system, etc. These estimates do not include operational cost to operate the church.

St. John XXIII rectory – estimated deferred maintenance cost \$26,750.00. To recapture the building health to "good health" will cost approximately \$2,675.00 annually over 10 years toward deferred maintenance items which include new roof and driveway sealcoating.

St John XXIII church building – estimated deferred maintenance \$298,000. To recapture the building health to "good health" will cost approximately \$29,800.00 annually over 10 years toward deferred maintenance items include replacement of HVAC system, carpet replacement, stucco repairs, lighting upgrades, etc. These estimates do not include operational cost to operate the church.

While there we will ride on buses that are handicapped accessible. The tour will last for two hours and will cost \$35.00. If you haven't been to the WILDS or if it has been a while, you should go. This is a fabulous treasure in Ohio. We suggest stopping for a small lunch, or sandwich, before getting to the WILDS. 

PLENARY INDULGENCES

The Dominican Order is currently celebrating a Triple Jubilee in honor of St. Thomas Aquinas, remembering the 700th Anniversary of his canonization (which was celebrated in July 2023), the 750th Anniversary of his death (which was celebrated on March 7, 2024), and the 800th Anniversary of his birth (which will be celebrated in 2025). In honor of these anniversaries, the Apostolic Penitentiary grants a Plenary Indulgence to those who make a pilgrimage to a holy place connected with the Dominican Order, and there devoutly take part in the jubilee ceremonies, or at least devote a suitable time to pious recollection, concluding with the Lord's Prayer, the Creed, and invocations of the Blessed Virgin Mary and of Saint Thomas Aquinas. Any church, shrine, or chapel currently entrusted to the Dominican Order can meet the requirements for the pilgrimage. In the Diocese of Columbus, St. Patrick Church in Columbus, St. Joseph Church in Somerset, and Holy Trinity Church in Somerset are entrusted to the Dominican Friars. The Plenary Indulgence may be obtained until January 28, 2025 under the usual conditions of Sacramental Confession 20 days before or after the indulgenced act, reception of Holy Communion, prayers for the Intentions of the Holy Father, and complete detachment from sin, including venial sin.
